Pass: no conditions are placed on the student.

Conditional pass: this is typically a written assignment to fulfill a shortcoming seen in the area paper. The time limit for completion will be set by the committee.

Unsatisfactory: if the examination results are unsatisfactory, there are three possible outcomes.

- a. Re-examination. This should occur no later than a week after the initial defense, if possible. This outcome usually indicates that the written portion of the area paper was satisfactory but the oral defense failed to meet expectations.
- b. Terminal master's degree. The committee may decide after your examination that your performance was not of a sufficient quality to proceed to doctoral candidacy. This decision by the committee will result in awarding of the M.S. degree and immediate termination from the Program.
- c. Termination for the program without the MS. The committee may decide that both the written area paper and the oral examination were of such poor quality that a master's degree will not be awarded. This decision will result in immediate termination from the Program with no awarding of an M.S. degree.
